Wine Type: Semi-Sweet Sparkling Young White Wine.

Grape Origin: Own vineyards. Pozanco Estate.

Wine Region: Wine from Extremadura Land (“Tierra de Barros” *Clay Land*). Spain.

Coupage: 75% Macabeo/Viura; 25% Cayetana

Vintage: 2016

Alcoholic Level: 9,5%

Tastin Notes:

Visual Stage: Pale Yellow with greenish highlights.

Smell Stage: In nose it reveals frank and intense, with white fruit aromas and light floral touches.

Taste Stage: Frank, round and intense, with a long persistence, that remembers the smell stage and a light vegetal touch, characteristic of macabeo grape. A few acid notes, well-integrated with sweetness. A light touch of carbonic gas adds a nice surprise.
